Dear students and parents,

As you know, we have an exchange program with a German High School, Offenburg, located in the Black Forest. Every two years we are taking students to travel to Europe and stay at the school. Our next trip will be in 2008.

The following is a planned itinerary, **all subject to change**.

- 1) Leave Pinetop on May 24th. Arrive in Offenburg on Sunday, May 25th.
- 2) Stay in school for 2 weeks. During this time will travel to Strasbourg- France, Venice- Italy, Heidelberg and Freiburg in Germany.
- 3) Leave Offenburg on June 9th, travel to Munich. Stay for three days. Visit downtown Munich, Concentration Camp Dachau, and Castle Neuschwanstein.
- 4) Friday 13th of June leave for Salzburg, Austria. Stay till Monday 16th. Visit salt mine and Mozart Haus etc.
- 5) Monday 16th leave for Prague, Tschech Republic. Will stay one full day. Wednesday June 18th leave for Berlin, capital of Germany.
- 6) Fly home from Berlin on June 21st. Arrive in Phoenix June 21st.

Costs (estimate)

Airfare	\$1000
Lodging (Youth Hostels+breakfast)	\$ 350
Train/Subway	\$ 250
Castle Trip	\$ 40
Entry Fees (museums/castles)	\$ 100
Food (13 days)	\$ 250
Souvenirs etc	a lot

The airfare can be paid for through our tax credit program. Please read the enclosed brochure. Any relative paying tax in Arizona can put money into tax credit for your child. You will get the money back the following year (state income tax), BRHS can use the money for the trip.
